TRADITIONAL DIVISION

Entries will be judged on traditional authenticity and artistic excellence within their tribal traditions.

CONTEMPORARY DIVISION

Contemporary entries will be judged on how well the individual has taken their traditional values and expanded it in a modern form of art and on artistic excellence
